TUFF TRUCK RULES

ALL contestants at every event must sign a waiver understanding that they are competing at their own risk and that they will not bring suit against any officials, employees, event sponsors, Checked Flag Productions, and/or property owner. By signing the release form you agree to all rules set forth. Drivers will be held responsible for the actions of their crew and family!

DRIVERS - Must be at least 18 years of age have a valid driver's license. Only one driver per vehicle, NO passengers allowed.

PIT HELP or CREW - The pit area or competitor staging area are restricted areas and only people who have signed the release and waiver form shall enter these areas. Pit area access will be allowed with a current Checked Flag Productions provided arm band that is issued at sign-up registration. No one under 16 years of age shall be allowed to receive an arm band or be in your pit area or crew during the event. This event is being held with a Monster Truck show or other event.

THE PIT AREA IS A DANGEROUS PLACE and by merely attending you risk life and limb. Be Safe and keep aware of other trucks and drivers. Keep out of harms way, and be careful around the other Trucks as they cannot see you. The pit area and competitor parking is no place for children. Leave them at home or have an adult supervision - we are not babysitters.

STOCK CLASS - Open to trucks or cars. Vehicles must be in good mechanical condition. No Pro-Arena type vehicles allowed in the stock class. DOT approved tires only. Must be stock frame-no tube frames. Shocks must be mounted in stock location. After market exhaust-open headers allowed. Suspension lift kits allowed. No nitrous oxide, Supercharges or turbo's. Headers and open exhaust permitted. Tuff truck competition is not open to dune buggies.

OPEN CLASS - This is basically 'run what yah bring class', but vehicle must have all safety equipment. Open class is open to dune buggies, Pro Arena type trucks, all modifications to suspension and frame can be any type. Must be a truck or Jeep type vehicle or also a dune buggy.

VEHICLE SAFETY - Roll bars, fire extinguisher, neck brace or any normal racing safety device is recommended. Drivers must be strapped in using either the stock seat belts or racing type harness. DOT helmet required. All vehicles must pass tech inspection before competing. If officials determine a vehicle is unsafe, officials have the right to not allow the vehicle to compete. Vehicles does not need to be street legal.

A CONTESTANT MAY BE DISQUALIFIED for either emotional or physical reasons by Competition Director or track officials. No RECKLESSNESS; DRUGS OR DRINKING ALCOLHOLIC BEVERAGES. Any driver or any of his/her pit crew consuming an intoxicating agent, and/or drugs, prior to or during the event will be disqualified from the event. Verbal or physical abuse towards any track official will result in disqualification. Vehicles must be operated in a safe manner at all times within the confines of the track, pit area, parking lot and staging areas. Track officials have the right to stop and disqualify any vehicle being operated in a reckless manner and driver might be subject to arrest.

THE RULES AND/OR REGULATIONS set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of competition events and to establish minimum acceptable requirements for such events.

BY PARTICIPATING IN THESE EVENTS, all participants are deemed to have complied with these rules and accept all risks. NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM PUBLICATIONS OF OR COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES AND/OR REGULATIONS. They are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to a participant, spectator, or official. The event director shall be empowered to permit minor deviation from any of the specifications herein or impose any further restrictions that in his opinion do not alter the minimum acceptable requirements.

NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM SUCH ALTERATION OF SPECIFICATIONS. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the officials. Their decision is final!

TUFF TRUCK CLASSES

STREET STOCK: No frame mods, must be street legal truck or jeep type vehicles.

OPEN PRO ARENA TYPE: Open to Pro Arena type trucks, open to buggies, if not street legal this is the class.

› Drivers negotiate an obstacle course as they race one at a time against a stopwatch.

› Most events drivers will have at least 2 attempts to better their time.

› One Truck = One Driver

› No passengers

› Come have some fun!!!
